Your donations are used to furnish our transitional and permanent apartments/houses. They are also given for free to families who are graduating from the program.

Please contact the Office Manager at 410-273-6700 to discuss your donation. Furniture donations must be dropped off by appointment. Furniture pick-ups are scheduled monthly as needed. When in doubt, please call.

Needed Items *All items must be in new or gently used condition.*

Household Items & Appliances

- Vacuum cleaners and bags, heating pads, iron and ironing boards, mops, buckets, brooms
- Small microwaves, toasters, coffee makers, mixers
- Pots and pans, bake ware, cooking utensils
- Full sets of dishes, flatware sets, knives
- Drinking glasses/cups
- Cutting boards, can openers, measuring cups & spoons
- Trash cans, hampers, storage containers
- Natural Gas stoves no larger than 30" in width
- Refrigerators no larger than 65" x 32" (no side by side)
- Twin and full sheet sets
- Towels & wash clothes for bath and kitchen, pot holders
- New pillows
- Shower curtains and bath mats

Maintenance & Repair Items

- Plumbing, HVAC & electrical supplies
- Nuts, bolts, screws, etc.
- Hand tools & power tools in good working condition, snow shovels
- New painting supplies (no used paint)
- Wall & screen repair items
- Large storage shed 14 ft. x 10 ft.
- Furnace filters: 16x20x1, 15x20x1, 14x25x1
- Window shades: 47in., 41 in., 40 in.

Furniture

- Beds: Bunk Beds or Twin (no queen or King) mattresses, box springs, frames. Full beds only as needed.
- Dressers without mirrors (no taller/longer than 5 feet)
- Sofas/Loveseats (no pullouts or sectionals)
- Kitchen tables & chairs
- Coffee tables & night stands (no glass tops please)
- Small microwave & TV stands
- Small desks, bookcases, desk chairs
- Table lamps (no halogen lighting)

Electronics

- TV's no larger than 24 inches
- VCR & DVD Players
- Converter Boxes for TV's
- Clocks/clock radios
- Digital cameras & camcorders
- Computers & laptops less than 3 years old
- Printers, copiers & scanners compatible with current technology

Baby/Children Items

- Unexpired car seats and boosters, strollers, cribs and crib mattresses, crib sheets, used bottles, new bottle nipples, cups, eating utensils and plates

- Knick-knacks, candles, clothing, mirrors
- Mugs, wine glasses or any alcohol related items
- Items that cannot be immediately used or are not currently in demand
- Recalled items
